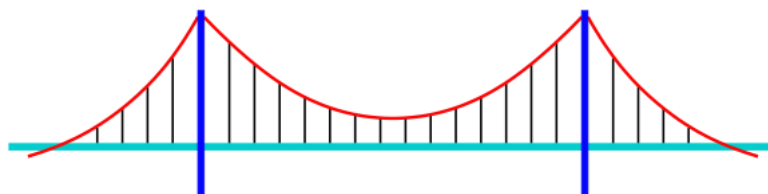

Cooperative Education is a unique educational strategy that combines on-the-job learning experiences with related classroom instruction.
